

## **Volusia County Well Ordinance FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions)**

1. How much will a permit cost now? **\$75.00 Private, \$50.00 Monitoring, \$150.00 Commercial.** ( Abandonment of wells are \$40.00 for surficial and \$80.00 for deep).
2. Will the Health Dept. permit and inspect in the cities also? **Yes. This ordinance applies to all areas of the county “Incorporated” or “Unincorporated”.**
3. How long will an approved permit be good for? **180 days.**
4. What is the time frame for scheduling an inspection? **24 hour notice**
5. What is required to schedule an inspection? **A well completion report submitted to the appropriate office.**
6. Is an inspection and approval by the health department required prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy by any building department? **Yes**
- 7 Is there a variance process? **Yes there is an appeal process for any denied applications. This process happens via the Volusia County Health Department.**
8. Is there a "hotline" to report unlicensed or un-permitted activities? **Yes you can call any of our four field offices.**
9. Can permits be applied for at any environmental health office? **Yes, you can also apply by fax if you are a well driller and have a credit card on file.
